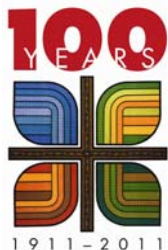

The Year of Grace 2012: Diocese of Des Moines Calendar Notes

- 1. Sunday, 20 November 2011, Christ the King:** The Centennial Jubilee year officially closes with this liturgical celebration. Mention in the petitions or an announcement is suggested.
- 2. Sunday, 27 November 2011, Advent I:** The Roman Missal, Third Edition, is promulgated in all ICEL nations. After this date, the Third Edition is the only edition that may be used. Please see the document “Roman Missal Quick Reference” for helpful information as we all acclimate ourselves to the new Missal.

Eucharistic Prayers for Masses with Children may be used in from the 1970 edition until they are offered in another publication. These texts may continue to be used with the new dialogues and words of institution interpolated into the prayer.
- 3. Holy Days of Obligation (Weekday):** Immaculate Conception, Thurs., 8 Dec. 2011; Assumption, Wed., 15 August 2012; All Saints, Thurs., 1 Nov. 2012.
- 4. Transferred Feasts and Observances:** Day of Prayer for Legal Protection of the Unborn transferred to Monday, January 23; Solemnity of the Annunciation of the Lord transferred to Monday, March 26, replacing Lenten weekday; Chrism Mass to be held on Thursday, March 29; Ascension of the Lord transferred to Sunday, May 20, replacing the Seventh Sunday of Easter
- 5. New Vigil Texts:** Epiphany, Ascension, and Pentecost have new vigil texts. The dates of these vigils are January 8, May 19, and May 26, respectively. Note also that the new texts for the Pentecost Vigil details and optional extended vigil which mirrors the Easter Vigil.
- 6. Chrism Mass:** Friday, March 30, 7 pm at the Cathedral. At Bishop Pates’ request, please make special encouragement and invitation to the following groups at your parish: RCIA catechumens, candidates, sponsors, team; children who are to be or were recently baptized, along with the parents and sponsors; youth preparing for the sacrament of Confirmation. Many thanks.
- 7. Diaconate Ordination:** Friday, June 1 at 7 pm at the Cathedral has been reserved for the diocesan seminarians who will be ordained deacons. Currently three seminarians, Fabian Moncada, Ross Parker, and Adam Westphal are in Theology III and on track for a June 1 diaconal ordination. Please pray for these and all of our seminarians.
