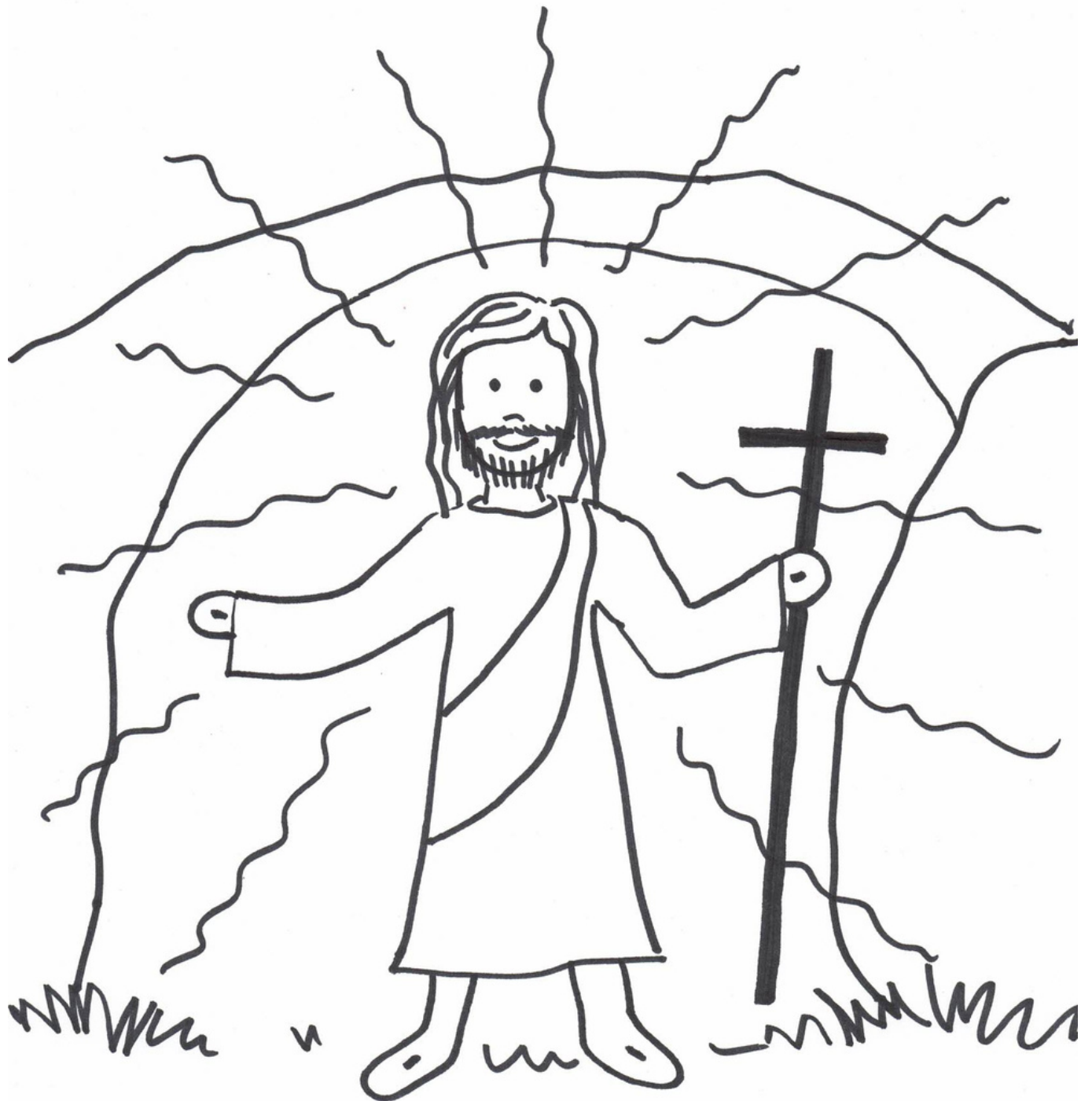

"While she was still crying, she bent down and looked inside the tomb. She saw two angels dressed in white."

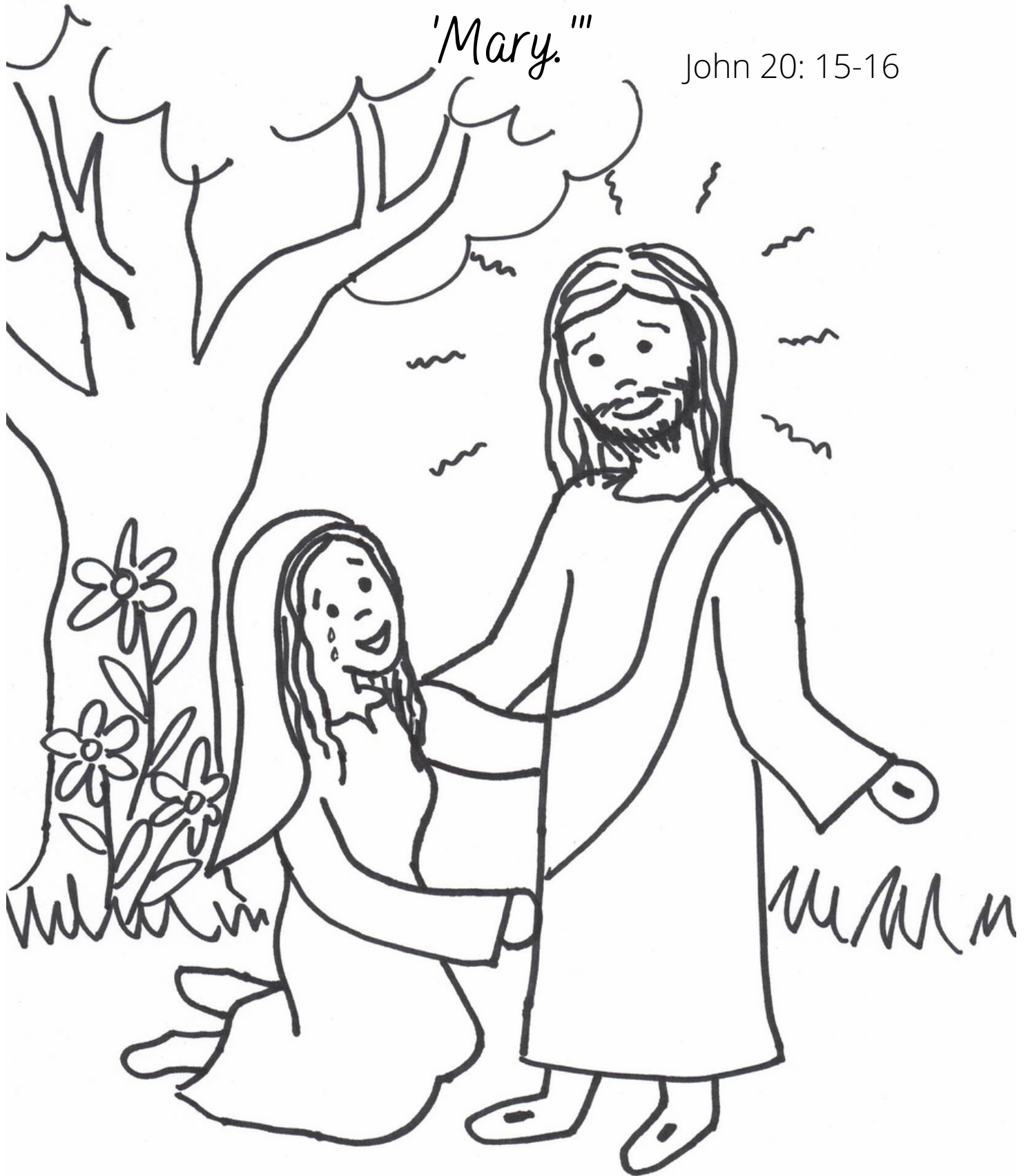
John 20: 11-12

Luke 24: 15, 21



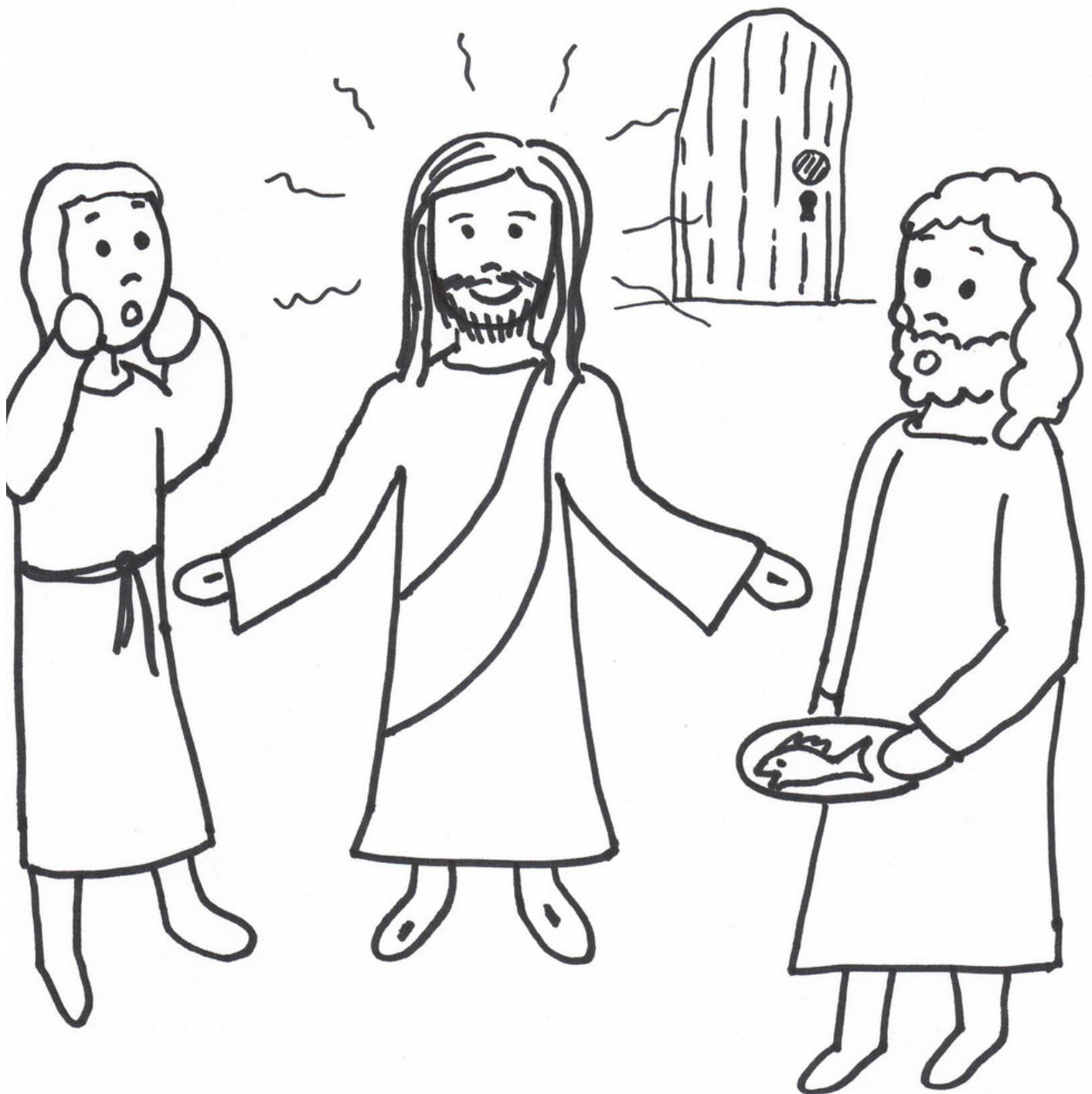
"... he took bread... and gave it to them.

John 21: 6-7



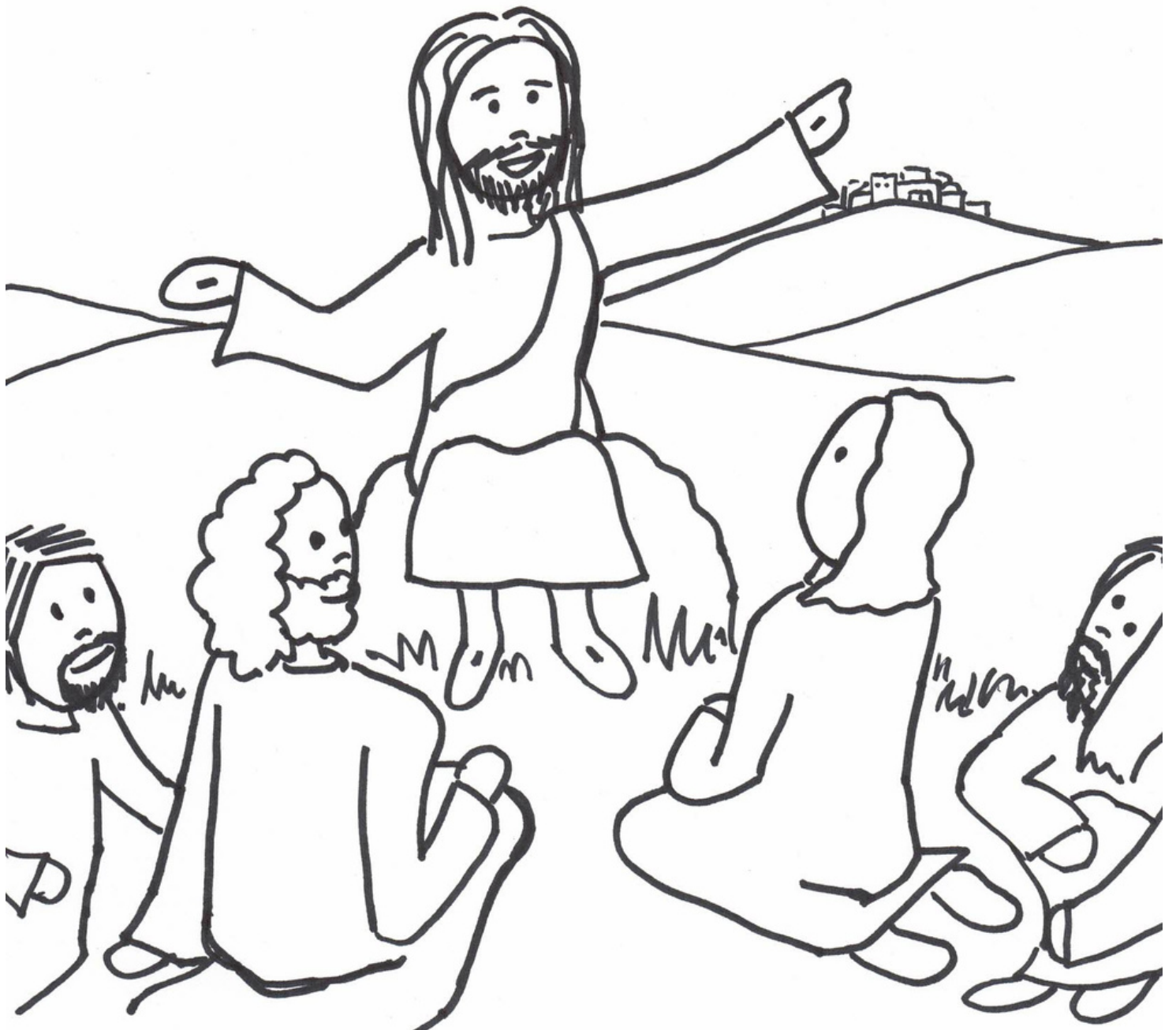
