

Christmas Sensory Bags

Make individual sensory bags that go along with the Christmas story. Have kids play with the bag as you read. Easy and inexpensive so you can make one for each child.

Fill sealable sandwich bag with hair gel shampoo or liquid soap that are unscented. Use nontoxic gel and avoid items that could be choking hazards. Add in fun stuff to squish around that goes with story you are reading. Examples include: Add stars with 1 bigger and brighter for star of Bethlehem. If add Lego figures, glue pieces together first.

Remember tape bag well with packaging tape to make extra secure so it can't be opened easily.

Could also make Christmas trees made out of craft foam and ask kids to move ornaments around on tree (sequins, shapes for ornaments, stars, etc.)
