Catholic Schools Policies/Regulations

STUDENT PERSONNEL

Admissions

It shall be the policy of the Diocesan Catholic Schools Board that students who are admitted to a Catholic school agree to abide by the philosophy and the educational policies and regulations of the school and the Diocese. This agreement shall be indicated through receipt of the Student Handbook and enrollment in the school.

Previous to admitting a transfer student, the school shall contact the administrator of the prior school. The purpose of the contact is to ascertain why the student wishes to transfer and to determine whether the school can meet the student's needs.

In the event an application to a Diocesan school should be made by a student expelled from another school; a careful investigation must be made by the school administrator. If the administrator desires the involvement of the local board in this investigation, the board chairperson shall appoint one member to assist. If a student who was expelled from another school is admitted, the enrollment may be probationary at the discretion of the administrator.
