- Do not respond to texts, emails, or calls about checks from the government. The details are still coming together.
- Ignore online offers for vaccinations and home test kits. There are no products proven to treat or prevent COVID-19 at this time.
- Hang up on robocalls. Scammers are using illegal robocalls to pitch everything from lowpriced health insurance to work-at-home schemes.
- Watch for emails claiming to be from the CDC or WHO. Use sites like <u>this</u> and <u>this</u> to get the latest information. And don't click on links from sources you don't know.
- Do your homework when it comes to donations. Never donate in cash, by gift card, or by wiring money.
