Anti-Virus Subscription Email Scams

By now, most of us are familiar with the typical phishing email scams going around, like a bad guy posing as a priest asking us to “do a favor”, “buy some gift cards” and they can’t be reached by phone because they are “in a meeting” or “in a prayer session”.

Another method the bad guys use is to pose as a representative from a service you may be using, such as a popular anti-virus program, claiming that your subscription has ended and your computer is at great risk of being “infected if you don’t pay the subscription cost”, which is usually several hundred dollars.
