THE YEAR OF GRACE 2026: A LITURGICAL CALENDAR

Eight hundred years after his passing into eternal life, St. Francis remains one of the most beloved saints of all time. The artwork in this year's calendar (2026) by artist Jen Norton depicts pivotal scenes from the life of St. Francis and seeks to foster a renewed appreciation for the ways he continues to inspire us today.

At the center of the calendar, Christ speaks to Francis at the church of San Damiano, calling him to rebuild the Church. The heart of Catholic and Franciscan spirituality is attentive listening to the voice of Christ and joyful pursuit of whatever he asks us to do. The corners of the calendar give us further glimpses of the unfolding work of grace in Francis' life as he follows the Lord's call. First, we see him forsake his father's wealth to embrace a life of gospel poverty, which soon inspires others to join him. Next, we see Francis developing a deepening love for Christ in the poor as he embraces a leper and joins the beggars outside St. Peter's Basilica in Rome. Filled with joy for having found the fullness of his heart's desire in God alone, Francis preaches the good news to all creation—bearing in his words and in his own body the marks of his beloved Savior. Finally, we see images of the enduring legacy that this Poverello ("poor man") of Assisi unleashed in the world by his response to Christ's invitation, and in which we are invited to participate by our own yes to Christ.

El Año de Gracia 2026 liturgical year follows the Sundays of Year A and the weekdays of Year II of the liturgical cycle, beginning November 30, 2025 (First Sunday of Advent) and ending Saturday, November 28, 2026.

LTP's circular display of the liturgical year makes its key features easily understandable. We can see at a glance the liturgical seasons in their characteristic colors, Sundays on the outer rim, and the days and weeks radiating from the center.

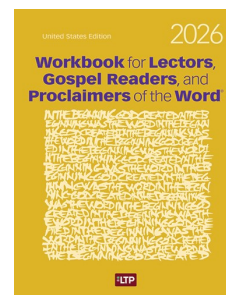

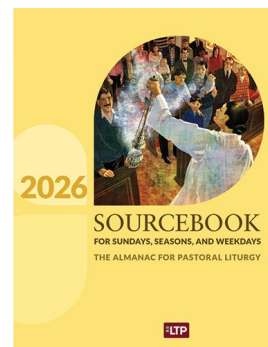

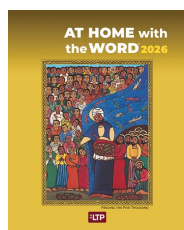

DAILY PRAYER 2026

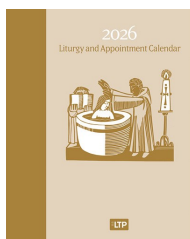

The calendar also includes other Catholic events and observances such as holydays of obligation, First Friday and First Saturday devotions, Catechetical Sunday, and more! Common secular and other non-Christian religious observances are noted as well. In recognition of the new translation of the *Order of Christian Initiation of Adults*, this year's calendar includes quotes from the ritual text as well as *Christian Initiation: General Introduction* and the *National Statutes for the Christian Initiation of Adults*.

CHILDREN'S DAILY PRAYER

Throughout the history of the Church, Christians have consecrated time by pausing at various moments throughout the day to pray the Liturgy of the Hours (*Guide for Celebrating Liturgy of the Hours*). *Children's Daily Prayer* is a form of the Liturgy of the Hours adapted for children. It helps guide children in a daily service of communal prayer, following the pattern of the Church's Morning Prayer.

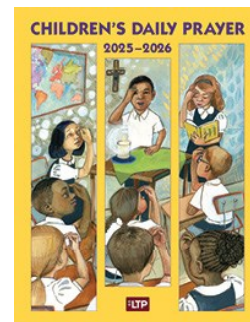
The heart of this annual resource is a simple order of prayer for each day and week that can be easily led by a child. Designed to fit seamlessly into your day, the entire prayer service takes no more than five to eight minutes. Daily Scripture texts have been carefully selected to help children "walk through the Bible" and become familiar with the great stories and themes of salvation history.

Children's Daily Prayer 2025 through 2026 includes:

- An order of prayer for each day and week of the school year from August 24, 2025, to June 26, 2026
- Prayer services, suitable for classroom and large gatherings, for solemnities, feasts, and other special occasions
- An "About the Season" section explaining each liturgical time, its character, and how to create conducive prayer environments
- Send-home pages connecting children's classroom and home lives

Instructions for parents on using the book with their children at home, and how to set up a prayer space.

Pronunciation guides have been added in the Opening sections and within the Scripture passages to accommodate young readers who will be leading prayer. Teachers, catechists, and parents can use *Children's Daily Prayer* to instill in children the habit of prayer and help form them in the heart of Christ's paschal mystery, the core and center of all liturgical prayer.

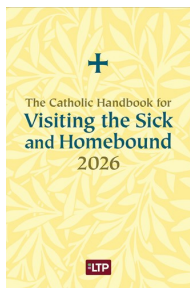

As an extension of the compassionate ministry of Jesus, ministers of care go forth from the Eucharistic celebration so that they may share the Word of God and holy Communion with those who are sick and cannot attend Sunday Mass. *The Catholic Handbook for Visiting the Sick and Homebound* compiles in one place all the rites a lay minister needs to perform this ministry with great care and sensitivity. The rites have been adapted for lay ministers and include those for sharing holy Communion and Viaticum, visiting the sick, blessing the sick and those who suffer, and praying with those who are dying. The Gospel texts for Year A, explanations of the readings, and a list of patron saints for those who are sick and suffering are also included in this resource, allowing ministers to more easily bring the Sunday Gospel to those in need. The 2026 edition includes the new translation of the rites from *Holy Communion and Worship of the Eucharistic Mystery outside Mass*.
